Transport from Prague to Plzen:

There is a quick and frequent public transport between Prague and Plzen - either by train or by bus. All timetables for the Czech Republic can be found here:

More specifically:

1) Direct trains leave Prague to Pilsen every hour. The journey takes an hour and a half; a standard ticket costs 100 CZK. Travel by a supercity "Pendolino" train costs 135 CZK (runs twice per day). The trains depart from Prague main railway station ("Praha hlavní nádraží" or "Praha hl. n.") and arrive at for Pilsen main railway station ("Plzeň hlavní nádraží" or "Plzeň hl. n.").

2) Buses leave Prague to Pilsen about every hour. The departure is either from the Zlicin terminal or from the UAN Florenc terminal, the destination station is "Plzeň CAN" (i.e., central bus station).

Travel from the Zlicin terminal takes about an hour, travel from the UAN Florenc terminal takes an hour and a half. The ticket costs again about 100 CZK (may vary according to the operator). Buses from the Zlicin terminal are usually operated by the StudentAgency operator,

with English speaking personnel.

3) If you arrive in Prague by air, you have to get either to the railway station or to the bus Zlicin terminal.

a) For the airport, there is a special "Airport Express" bus from the airport to the railway station. The journey takes about 40 minutes, the cost is about 60 CZK, see

b) For the Zlicin bus terminal, there is a public transport bus no.100. The journey takes about 20 minutes and the cost is about 30 CZK. Please buy the ticket in advance at the public transportation kiosk in the airport arrival hall.
